# Make it easy for your team to connect

## Problem



Distributed employees **don't have any face time with leadership**

Employees **don't know team members from other departments** well

Employees **rarely meet with coworkers** from other locations



## Impact

The team **lacks connections** to customers, company goals, and mission

**Low cohesion** when working on cross-functional projects

Lack of trust, bonding, and relationships leads to **low engagement**



## Solution



Executives visit local hubs to **work with the team** and talk company goals

**Monthly get-togethers** for all employees working near a local hub

Local teams host **quarterly kickoff events** for team-building and project-planning



## Outcome

Immediate **improvements** in **alignment, goals,** and **productivity**

Improved relationships and trust between teams lead to **better project outcomes**

Stronger **sense of belonging,** **higher engagement,** and **lower turnover**

# How to foster in-person connections with Gable

## 1 Identify a culture carrier in each location


Reward employees who build culture by empowering them to host events with their colleagues and drive attendance and collaboration.

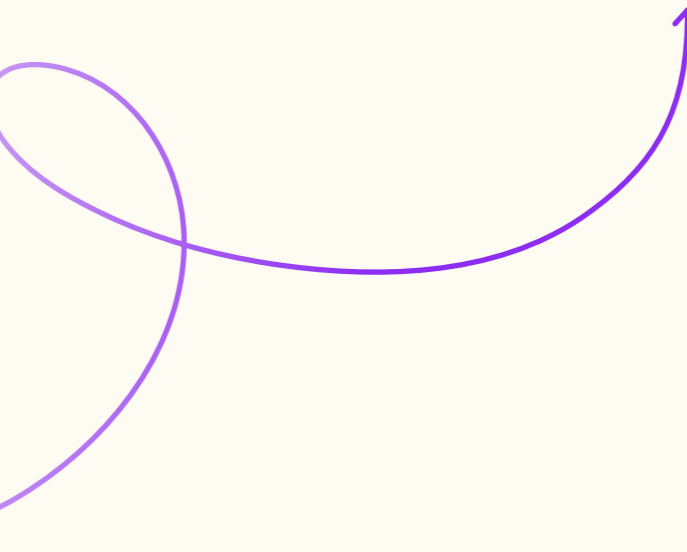
## 2 Set up a company gatherings playbook

Instead of reinventing the wheel, set up basic guidelines and suggestions for local meetup scenarios. Include budget, suggested vendors and any form of reporting employees need to submit.

## 3 Give shout-outs for team meetings

Have one hub meeting? Highlight their get-together as an example for the whole company. Share photos on Slack, send them coffee, or give out benefits points to your most engaged groups to motivate others to join.
